Easy Church Access for Anyone with Limited Mobility

The Parish is aware that some parishioners have difficulty negotiating the paths at the front of the church. There are plans to change the access to a more gentle incline and to install handrails, but this is a complex and expensive task which will take some time to put in place.

AS AN INTERIM STRATEGY, STARTING THIS WEEK, THE GATE FROM THE SMALL CAR PARK NEXT TO THE PARISH OFFICE WILL BE OPENED FOR EACH MASS.

This will provide a flat footpath access from the car park to the church, which should make access much easier for anyone who has limited mobility. Lighting along this path has also been upgraded for use when needed. Parishioners are asked to only use this access if they have a need to do so. It is hoped that opening this access way will be of benefit until a permanent solution is implemented.
