The Easter mystagogical instruction continues. Today we reflect on life as a journey. This theme expresses well the fact that life is not static, but is a movement from one point to another. Actually, we do not so much make the

Like the two disciples travelling to Emmaus, we have certain expectations which Jesus does not seem to fulfil.
