#### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT -YEAR B

Dear Friends,

As we are at the threshold of another Lenten journey, we have a reminder from Saint Catherine of Siena: *"Nothing great is ever achieved without much enduring."* During Lent we are invited to commit ourselves to staying close to Christ and learning to follow Him.

#### "God himself will set me free from the hunter's snare."

This verse, which repeats in the Church's Morning Prayer throughout Lent, reminds us of the season's basic message: *"God saves us."* 

We all stumble into snares. Perhaps we feel bound by sinful habits, fear of our own mortality, trauma, unhealthy compulsions, raw grief, or simply the monotony of daily routine. And when we feel stuck, it's difficult to conceive how we will ever get free.

However, Lent brings us good news: Jesus guides us through death and into new life. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, the three pillars of Lent, educate us about selfless love and help us forge new paths through life.

Let us seek to overcome our weaknesses, not in an attempt to merit God's forgiveness, but to live with the freedom that only the children of God enjoy. Let us not be afraid of failures, because God's love is bigger than our deepest imperfection. All He wants is for us to keep following Him, closely and sincerely.
