### REFLECTION by Fr Michael Tate

#### **Transfigured Bodysouls**

St Thomas Aquinas famously said: 'If only my soul is saved, I am not saved.' And yet many Christians do think that our ultimate goal is, by the grace of God, to

end up as souls in Heaven.

No, I am a human being, bodysoul. If I am to be saved, then this stardust, this fraction of material creation, this earthling, needs to be immersed into Divine energy and light.

The Transfiguration of Jesus Christ, especially as recounted in the other gospels, shows what happens when human nature is in total communion with God. Every molecule of his body was evidently pulsing with Divine energy and light. The amazing truth is that God ardently desires that each one of us should share in the transfigured life of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

For this to occur, we must play our part, accepting that Jesus of Nazareth is indeed the Beloved Son of God, listen to him, and put into practice what we hear.

We could take a moment to pray that after the "repose of the soul" after death, we may participate as bodysouls in the transfigured humanity of the Risen Lord.

#### Dear Friends.

Suppose that anytime your life becomes too challenging and you lose motivation to live, you receive a tidbit from your future life to motivate you. The news that even this difficult moment will pass, could comfort you. In the gospel today, the scene of the Transfiguration accomplishes something similar to console Jesus' disciples. They did not want the moment of transfiguration to pass. This vision prepared them to face the suffering and death of Christ with courage.

Allow me to introduce you to St. Bruno Sserunkuuma, who was born in Uganda in 1856 as a chief's son. He became a page in the king's palace. As a child of privilege, he was recalled by others as an aggressive, harsh, and inebriated person. But while he was at the palace, he developed a deep love for the Catholic faith, and at the age of 29, he was baptised. His character improved and he started living as a good Christian. However, as a reward for his great service the king gave him two women as his wives. The head page Charles Lwanga (later a martyr and saint) reminded him of his baptismal promises.

It was a moment of transfiguration for Bruno. He had a choice to make: was he a son of a chief, or was he a son of God? If he was son of a chief, he had a lot of living to do; if he was a son of God, there was a lot of dying ahead. Bruno chose to live as a son of God and walked away from these relationships. The king eventually grew weary of the Christian faith of Bruno and his friends and demanded that they renounce their Catholic faith. St. Charles Lwanga the head page and his companions (including Bruno) refused to deny their faith. Bruno constantly and bravely encouraged others not to give up. He died a martyr on June 3, 1886.

St Bruno Sserunkuuma is an example for the power of transfiguration moments. He was convinced that the glory that awaited him upon his resurrection outweighed all the delights and sufferings of this world.

Let us, like the disciples Peter, James, John, and St. Bruno, which has been traverse life's frequently challenging path with integrity, so many of us. being mindful of the glory of the resurrection.
